Oasis Systems LLC Purchase Order D21-041

Sub-Contractor Flow-Down Requirements

When the products or services provided under this Purchase Order (PO) are furnished in connection with a U.S. Government Prime Contract or Subcontract issued to Oasis Systems, LLC (Oasis), the following Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and Department of Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) clauses identified below shall also apply to this PO as required by law or regulation. All FAR and DFARS clauses are incorporated into this PO by reference with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text. The effective version of each FAR or DFARS clause shall be the same version as appears in the Prime Contract, or Subcontract under which this PO is issued. In the event there is no such equivalent clause in the Prime Contract or Subcontract, the date shall be the regulatory date in effect as of the date of this PO.

The applicability and interpretation of each clause are subject to any specific parenthetical statement following its title. In the event of a conflict between these FAR or DFARS provisions and the terms of the main body of this PO, the terms in the main body of this PO shall control. The Contracts Disputes Act shall have no application to this PO; any reference to a "Disputes" clause shall mean the "Disputes" clause of the Oasis Terms & Conditions associated with this PO.
